Sub: Request to consider operation of Garment Factories with 100% Capacity.

We highly appreciate the concerted efforts taken by the Government of Karnataka under your dynamic leadership to curb the ill effects of COVID-10, especially after the onset of second wave. As responsible corporate citizens, we are with the Government in its effort to control the spread. We have advised all our member units in the State of Karnataka to strictly adhere to the SOPs prescribed by the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Government of Karnataka. You were kind enough to allow the Garment Factories to function with 30% capacity.

We would now kindly request to allow the Garment Factories to function with full capacity due to the following reasons:-

1. The Garment Factories follow Assembly line system and they are unable to function properly and execute the export orders with 30% capacity.
2. Our member units have vaccinated their workers to the extent of 70% and many of them have vaccinated to the extent of 100%.
3. Other neighbouring States have allowed functioning of Garment Factories with full capacity.

We therefore urgently request the Karnataka State Government to allow the Garment Factories to function with full capacity, at the earliest.
