

Advantage UP

- One of India's fast-growing economies, contributing nearly
 8% to National GDP (FY17-FY21)
- India's 4th Largest State by area lying adjacent to National Capital, Delhi
- 5th Manufacturing state and 5th exporting state of India
- ➤ **Highest MSME base** (Registered) in India (14.2%)
- ➤ India's Largest consumer base with 240 million population (16.5% of total Indian population)
- Achiever State in 2020 and 2nd rank in Business Reforms Action Plan Ranking 2019
- ➤ Land bank more than 12000 acres (50 square kilometres) at key economic zones and along expressways/corridors
- ➤ Abundant Skilled Manpower, 75 Universities ,4000+colleges, 125,000+ ITI seats and world class institutes like IIT-K, IIT-BHU, IIM-L, etc.

Overview of Textile and Apparel Sector

India

- Indian textiles and apparel industry stood at USD 152 bn (2021)
- ➤ India 6th largest exporter of Textiles & Apparel in the world
- India's textiles export stood **USD 42 billion (2021)**, aims to reach **USD 100 billion exports (2027)**
- > India's readymade garment exports stood USD 17 billion (2021), aim to reach USD 30 billion (2027)
- India is one of the largest producer of cotton in the world accounting for about 22% of the world cotton production

UP

- > 5th largest numbers of handloom in India
- Exports of USD 2.7 billion of Textile, Apparels & Carpets
- > State known for carpets and produce **90% of India's carpets**
- ➤ India's major garmenting cluster exist at Ghaziabad-Noida, with presence of ~3000 units


















Existing Textile and Apparel Manufacturing Clusters in UP


Agra/Fatehpur Sikri – Mats, Cotton fabrics, Bed Sheets, Furnishings, Chenille cotton carpets







Policy Ecosystem: Key Incentives under Textile and Garmenting Policy 2022



Proposed Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Park

- Government of India (GoI) plans to set up PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Park in 1,000 acres (4 square kilometres) with an aim to create a modern, integrated large scale, world class industrial infrastructure including plug and play facilities (UP has earmarked 1,000 acres of land near state capital, Lucknow and submitted a competitive proposal to the GoI)
- Park envisaged to help India in achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 9 ("Build resilient infrastructure, promote sustainable industrialization and foster innovation").
- Park will create a conducive ecosystem for entire value-chain of the textile industry, reduce logistics costs and improve competitiveness
- Park Inspired by 5F Vision for Textile and Apparel sector, "Farm to Fibre to Factory to Fashion to Foreign".


