AS YOU ARE PROBABLY AWARE, THIS EDITION OF THE NORTH INDIA GARMENT FAIR IS A <u>NO DECORATION FAIR. ALL EXHIBITORS WILL BE</u> <u>ALLOTTED SHELL SCHEME STALLS ONLY AND NO BARE SPACE WILL BE</u> <u>ALLOTED TO THE EXHIBITORS IN THIS FAIR.</u>

DO'S & DON'T'S

All Exhibitors must Strictly Adhere to the following Rules & Regulations:

- 1. The Fair Timing will be from 10.00 A.M to 7.00 P.M. on All Three Days.
- 2. **SMOKING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED** in the Entire Exhibition Area, including the Cafeteria &Toilets.
- 3. PHOTOGRAPHY IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the Entire Exhibition Area.
- 4. ANY PERSON BELOW THE AGE OF 15 YEARS WILL STRICTLY NOT BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE FAIR AREA OR UNDERTAKE ANY WORK.
- 5. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO APPOINT ONLY LICENSED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS TO CARRY OUT ELECTRIC WORK IN THEIR STALL.
- 6. Garments / Textiles brought into the Exhibition Area will not be permitted to be taken outside the Exhibition Hall till the end of the Fair.
- 7. The Maximum Height permissible for all the Stalls will be <u>2.35 Mtr. Only</u> to maintain uniformity.
- 8. No Platform will be allowed inside the Allotted Stall.
- 9. Exhibitors can install their own Lights but **FLOOD LIGHTS AND HALOGEN LIGHTS ARE STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED** in the Stalls as they are Fire Hazard and reduce the effectiveness of Air Conditioning thereby causing inconvenience to all.
- 10. Exhibitors cannot keep any Furniture, Display materials, Mannequins, Standees etc. outside the Stall or in the Passage Way.

- 11. Whilst No Decoration will be permitted inside the stall or outside the stall or in the passageway, exhibitors will be permitted to use Flex & Posters of their Brand/s, etc to decorate the walls of their stall. Only. The wooden /Aluminium frame required to mount their Flex will be permitted to be used in their stall. No Carpentry work, polishing or painting will be allowed in the stall or in the entire Exhibition Area. Any use of thermocol, cotton, grass etc. or any inflammable material will not be permitted inside the stall.
- 12. Exhibitors will be permitted to bring their own Raiser, Modular Set-up, Furniture, Preassembled props, decorative racks, stands & mannequins, LCD Monitors, etc. Exhibitors will also be permitted to install LED wall in their stall with Prior Intimation & Permission from the CMAI Office provided it is Self Standing as the Shell Scheme wall will not be able to support the weight of the led wall.
- 13. The exhibitor will also have to inform the CMAI Office of the Additional Power Load required for the LED wall by 20th May 2025 and shall have to Pay for the Additional Power Load i.e. Rs. 3500/- + 18% GST per KW.

Note ; - If found, any Exhibitor is using more Power than the Allotted Quota, the Charges for the same will have to be paid on the spot. Failing to do so, Association reserves the Right to Disconnect / Discontinue the Power supply in the respective Stalls.

- 14. Soft music will be Permitted in the stall provided it does not disturb / cause any inconvenience to the fellow Exhibitors. The Association reserves the right to ask the exhibitor to stop playing the music if it receives any complaint of disturbance / causing inconvenience to the fellow Exhibitors.
- 15. No suspension or any hanging display will be Permitted from the Trusses or the Air Condition ducts of the Exhibition Halls. Similarly no fittings or display will be Permitted to be nailed. Screwed or drilled on to the floor, column, wall or any other part of the Hall. The same will be removed immediately and the exhibitor will be penalised for the damage caused to the property.
- 16. This is a notice to all CMAI Member Manufacturers and Exhibitors. Please be aware that playing or sharing sound recordings in public without the proper permissions is a violation of the Copyright Act, 1957. If you break this law, you could face fines, penalties, or other damages. CMAI will not be responsible for any fines or penalties that result from such violations; individual members or exhibitors will have to pay these themselves. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that all CMAI Member Manufacturers and Exhibitors obtain the necessary licenses or permissions before playing or sharing sound recordings in public.
